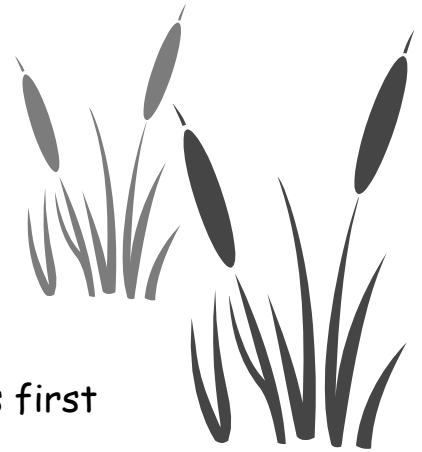


BULL CREEK NATURE WALK

Saturday October 30, 2010
9:00 - 11:00 a.m.



You are invited to San Fernando Valley Audubon's first nature walk at Bull Creek. **(Free)**

Stroll through this special place with a knowledgeable leader. Learn about the Bull Creek Ecosystem Restoration Project. What is its purpose? What are the plants and animals found in this new habitat? Where does the water come from and where does it go? What are the project's problems? What is its future?

Time and Meeting Place: The Bull Creek Ecological Restoration Project is just east of Balboa Boulevard, between Balboa Boulevard and Lake Balboa (Beilenson) Park. Meet in the dirt overflow parking lot to the west of Lake Balboa Park at 9:00 a.m.

Directions: Go north on Balboa Blvd. from Burbank Blvd. Travel about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the sign for Lake Balboa. Turn right onto the park road, then left into the dirt parking lot. Or go south on Balboa Blvd. from Victory Blvd. Travel about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to the sign for Lake Balboa. Turn left onto the park road, then left into the dirt parking lot.

Equipment and Clothing: Wear sturdy shoes, a cap or hat with a brim, and layered clothing. Bring binoculars if you have them.
