## The Audubon Photography Awards Traveling Exhibition

Artist's Reception is May 4, 2019 from 5 to 7 pm

Join the San Fernando Valley Audubon Society and the San Fernando Valley Arts & Cultural Center for two great exhibitions. "Call of the Wild" is a juried exhibition where artists and photographers explore their artistic relationship with flora and fauna in nature, featuring many of our wonderful local (and not so local) artists and photographers.

In order to inspire and inform people from communities across North America, the National Audubon Society created the [Audubon Photography Awards Exhibition](#), which brings a traveling exhibit of award-winning photos to Audubon centers and chapters in a variety of cities and towns. **This is the only exhibit of these wonderful photographs in Southern California!**

Selected from more than 8,000 entries, the winning photos were published in the Summer 2018 issue of *Audubon Magazine* and show birdlife at its most vivid, vulnerable, formidable, and elegant. The Audubon Photography Awards Exhibition is sponsored by Canon.

**Call of the Wild**, like all other exhibits at the SFVACC, is a free exhibit open to the public, and is partially funded by grants from the Los Angeles Department of Cultural Affairs and the Los Angeles County Arts Commission.
